The memorable event concluded with the singing of the National Anthem, leaving everyone motivated to work together for a successful and productive academic year.

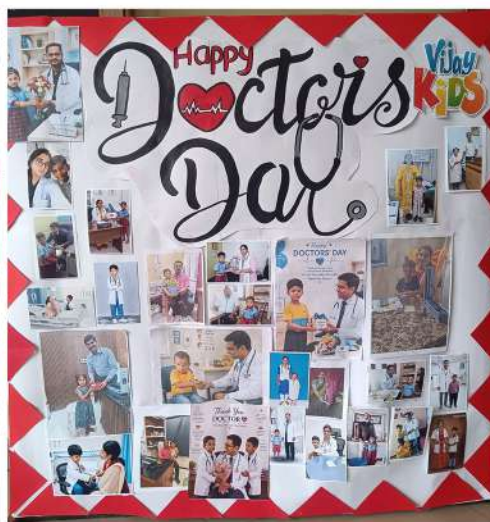

ECA ACTIVITIES

Our school is delighted to provide a wide range of extracurricular activities for students of classes I to VIII, ensuring holistic growth and joyful learning beyond academics. Children actively participate in sessions such as Taekwondo, which builds strength and discipline; Classical Dance, which nurtures rhythm and cultural appreciation; Keyboard, which enhances musical creativity; Skating, which develops balance and coordination; and the traditional martial art Silambam, which promotes agility, focus, and respect for heritage. In addition, uniform bodies such as Cubs and Bulbuls for classes III to V and Scouts and Guides for classes VI to VIII play a vital role in instilling teamwork, discipline, and leadership qualities. To ensure effective learning, trained coaches guide the students in each activity, while in-charge teachers support them by maintaining discipline and encouraging active participation. The schedule is thoughtfully planned: for the Primary Section (Std. 1–5), ECA periods are held every Wednesday during the first and second hours, while for the Middle Wing (Std. 6–8), they take place in the third and fourth hours on Wednesdays. These activities not only provide joyful exploration but also help students build confidence, creativity, and a sense of responsibility, making Wednesdays a day of vibrant energy and holistic development across the school.
